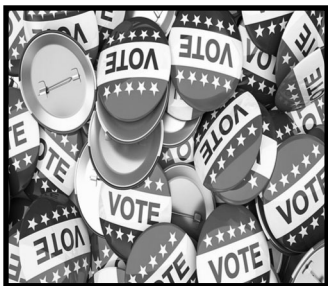


Brush and Compost Site

The Village of Prairie du Sac's Brush and Compost Site is available to dump items from village properties. To be an eligible property, the property tax bill for the property must be paid to the Village of Prairie du Sac. A mailing address of Prairie du Sac does not necessarily qualify a property. The site is located at 1005 19th Street in the northwest corner of the Prairie du Sac Industrial Park. Residents do not need to check out a key. The site is open 24/7 and is under video surveillance.

The Brush and Compost Site may be used to drop off allowable items that come from properties located in the Village of Prairie du Sac (pay property taxes to the Village of Prairie du Sac) in the assigned locations:

- Grass Clippings
- Garden/Yard Waste
- Leaves
- Wood Chips
- Brush

Please remember to register at www.myvote.wi.gov, if there is a change of name or address.

At all elections now in Wisconsin, voters must show an acceptable photo ID before a ballot will be provided. Please see prairiedusac.net for additional information.

Anything else will be considered illegal dumping and will be prosecuted. Only biodegradable bags are accepted at the site. Any other type of bags - grocery, plastic, etc. would be considered illegal dumping. No dumping items from properties that are outside the corporate limits of the Village of Prairie du Sac. If the property taxes for the property are not paid to the Village of Prairie du Sac, the property is not eligible to dump items at the site.

Mulch/wood chips and compost are available for residents at the site. The mulch/wood chips is the result of chipping brush that is either dropped off at the site or collected curbside. The compost is created by the decomposition of organic matter such as yard waste that is either dropped off at the site or collected curbside.

Village of Prairie du Sac Installing AEDs in Local Parks

More than 350,000 people go into cardiac arrest each year outside of hospitals, according to the American Heart Association (AHA). AHA says a person's chance of surviving drops by 7% to 10% every minute a normal heartbeat isn't restored, but immediate Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) use can double or triple the person's chance of survival. AEDs are intended for use by the public (lay responders). They are portable, safe, accurate and easy to use.



Recently, the Village of Prairie du Sac began installing cabinets with AEDs in its parks. The first cabinet was recently installed in Culver Community Park by the Village's Public Works/Utilities Department. To access the AED inside the heated cabinet, one dials 911. The Sauk County Sheriff's Department Dispatch will then provide instructions and the access code to open the cabinet. When the AED itself is open it provides audible instructions on how to use it. Dispatch will send first responders to the scene.

The Village will install two more of the cabinets at its Westwynde Park and Veterans Memorial Park with hopes to install more of the AED cabinets at other parks soon. The three cabinets being installed in 2024 were partially funded by the Sauk Prairie Healthcare Foundation's Healthy Life Grant.

2024 Fall Clean Sweep Event

Clean Sweep is an opportunity for homeowners, agricultural enterprises, and businesses to dispose of hazardous products and items that pose an environmental risk, such as pesticides and toxic cleaning products. Hazardous waste will be collected at no charge; however, there are fees for tires, some electronic items, and appliances.



Latex paint and motor oil are not accepted at the Sauk County Clean Sweep. Latex paint is non-hazardous, but it must be solidified before throwing away. It's easy to dry out: If you have a small amount, simply remove the lid and allow it to dry. Mix larger amounts with cat litter or a paint-drying product sold at hardware stores. Never dispose of liquid paint in your trash.
