

DENIAL OF APPLICATION

Applications may be denied for any of the following reasons:

- If it is a use which involves a violation of a Federal or State law or any provision of the Village Code of Ordinances.
- If the application is incomplete or not made timely.
- If the use of the park would require services and support beyond what is available.
- The proposed use would create a substantial risk to persons or damage of property.
- The proposed use is organized so that participants are likely to engage in destructive or aggressive activity.
- Any other reason specified by Village Ordinance.

PERMIT REVOCATION

The Village Board may revoke a permit if the Board feels that the action is justified due to an emergency such as weather, fire, riot, or other catastrophe. It may also revoke a permit if it feels a breach of peace is likely or the conditions on which the permit was granted have changed considerably.

SUMMARY OF PARK REGULATIONS

Sec.4-6 Code Ordinance
Village of Prairie du Sac

Purpose and Definition

These regulations have been enacted to preserve and protect Village parks, parkways, recreational facilities and conservancy areas from injury, damage, or desecration.

The term “parks” refers to all grounds, structures, and watercourses located within the designated parks, recreational facilities or conservancy districts in the Village.

This brochure summarizes Section 4-6 of the Code of Ordinance and does not replace any additional stipulations within the Code Section.

Specific Regulations for All Village Parks

Littering is Prohibited: You may not litter, dump, deposit rubbish, refuse, earth, or other material in any park.

Sound Devices: You may not operate or play an amplifying system unless you first obtain specific authority from the Village Board.

Pets: Dogs are prohibited in the Village parks.

Removal of Park Equipment: You may not remove benches, seats, tables, or other park equipment unless authorized by the Village Administrator.

Golf: You may not golf or hit any golf ball in a Village park. Frisbee Golf is available and permitted in Marion Park.

Fires: Fires are allowed only in personal grills or designated fireplaces. Personal grills may be used only in designated picnic areas and are permitted only so as lawns and vegetation are not endangered. Unburned fuel and ashes must be disposed of in such a manner to prevent fire or damage to any park property.

Protection of Park Property: No one may kill, injure, or disturb waterfowl birds, or animals, wild or domestic, within any park. You may not in any manner, injure or deface, write upon or ill use of any tree, shrub, flower, flower bed turf, soil, sand, fountain, ornament, building structure, apparatus, bench, table, official notice sign, or other property within the park or any of the facilities of the municipal swimming pool. This prohibition includes climbing trees, picking flowers or parts of shrubs, and digging in the ground or flower beds.

Beverage Bottles: Glass bottles are prohibited in parks.

Vehicles: Except for municipal vehicles, no person may operate or park any vehicle in the park, except in park roads and designated park areas.

Camping: Overnight camping is allowed only in the VFW Park and only from 6:00 p.m. on the Friday before Memorial Day until 6:00 p.m. on the last day of October each year for no longer than a 7 day period.

Reservation of Florence, Marion, and Westwynde Park Shelters

Policy on Reservation

The Village owned park, park facilities, and shelter areas in Florence, Marion, and Westwynde Parks, are primarily for non-exclusive use of the residents and visitors of the Village. However, under proper circumstances, exclusive use of Florence, Marion, and Westwynde Park shelters shall be permitted. Anyone may reserve the use of Florence, Marion, and Westwynde Park shelters by a written or online application filed with the Village Hall (608-643-2421). The person reserving the shelter must be present during the entire event.

Application

Reservations accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Applications shall be filed with the Village Hall at least three (3) days prior to the requested date of use. An application may be filed after January 1 of the year of the requested reservation. An additional shelter is available for non-exclusive use at Elsing & Fieldstone Parks.

Payment

All applicants for reservation of a park shelter shall pay with the application, a nonrefundable \$40.00 fee per shelter for Village residents or an \$80.00 fee per shelter for non-residents, within 10 days of reserving the shelter, prior to reservation date. Reservations are not valid until payment is received. A reservation will be issued to persons with a valid reservation.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be received at least 30 days prior to date of the reservation to receive a refund.
