Refuse Schedule

Monday: Limbs for chipping are limited to 12' long. Clean wood (no nails, metals, tar paper or tar shingles attached), pallets, garden and yard waste, weeds, twigs.

Wednesday: Loose leaves and grass clippings will be picked up once a week from May 31 to October 1 with the Leaf Vacuum. Grass clippings, leaves and yard waste placed in biodegradable bags will be picked up (no sticks, not exceeding 50 lbs.)

Friday: Concrete will be picked up. If this is a large amount, please notify the Village Hall at 643-2421.

Should a holiday fall on Monday, brush will not be picked up that week.

Items should be put out the night before the scheduled day.

Spring Cleanup: Loose leaves and grass

clippings will be picked up using the Leaf Vacuum in the

Spring from approximately **April 1 thru May 31** and in the Fall approximately October 1 thru November 15

(dependent upon the weather). Loose

leaves and grass clippings must be placed in the tree bank, **not in the gutter or**

street. Sticks or other items mixed in with the grass/leaves will not be pick up. There

are no set days when the Leaf Vacuum will be in your neighborhood. It may take several

days to make it through the entire Village.

Please note that snow, rain, workload, volume of refuse or emergencies may affect the refuse pick-up schedule. Therefore, pick-up could be delayed.


