SEC. 1-2-1 AUTHORIZATION FOR USE OF CITATION.

- (a) Authority. Pursuant to the authority of Wisconsin Statute Section 66.0113, as amended, the Village of Prairie du Sac hereby elects to adopt and authorize the use of a citation to be issued for violations of ordinances, including ordinances for which a statutory counterpart exists.
- (b) Citation. The form of the citation is hereby prescribed as found in Section 66.0113(1)(b), Wis. Stats., as amended, which is incorporated herein by reference.
- (c) Schedule of Cash Deposits. A schedule of cash deposits is established by Section 1-2-3 below, which is incorporated herein by reference.

SEC. 1-2-2 OFFICIALS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE CITATION.

Citations authorized in Section 1-2-1 above may be issued by law enforcement officers of the Village and by designated Village officials with respect to sections of the Code which are directly related to the official's area of responsibility. The officials granted authority to issue citations under this Section may delegate the authority to other Village employees within the designated official's department with the approval of the Village Board.

SEC. 1-2-3 SCHEDULE OF CASH DEPOSITS.

The schedule of cash deposits for the various ordinances for which a citation may be issued are as established on the deposit schedule adopted by the Sauk Prairie Court Commission, a copy of which is on file with the Administrator or Chief of Police. Except for parking citations, in addition to the deposit amount listed, the deposit must include all fees, assessments and costs as imposed by Section 800.10, Wis. Stats., as amended.

SEC. 1-2-4 FORM OF CITATION

The form of the citation to be used by the Village of Prairie du Sac is on file in the office of the Sauk Prairie Chief of Police and is adopted by reference as though fully set forth herein.

SEC. 1-2-5 RECEIPT OF CASH DEPOSITS.

Deposits shall be made in cash, money order or certified check to the Sauk Prairie Municipal Court Clerk. Receipts shall be given for all deposits received.

Section 66.119(3) of Wisconsin Statutes relating to violator's options and procedure on default, is hereby adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

SEC. 1-2-7 NONEXCLUSIVITY OF CHAPTER.

- (a) Adoption of this Chapter does not preclude the Village Board from adopting any other ordinance providing for the enforcement of any other law or ordinance relating to the same or other matters.
- (b) The issuance of a citation hereunder shall not preclude the Village or any authorized officer from proceeding under any other ordinance or law or by any other enforcement method to enforce any ordinance, regulation or order.
