

Where Does Your Pet License Money Go??

Pet license monies are distributed to Sauk County. After deducting the cost of the tags and required publications, the County pays the State the mandated fees and the rest of the money goes to help fund the Sauk County Humane Society. A very small portion is kept by the Village to help cover our expense of processing these licenses.

2020 Local Street Improvements

On November 26, 2019, the Village of Prairie du Sac Board of Trustees appropriated funds for the following streets and utility projects for the 2020 year:

6th Street Reconstruction – Ray Street to Grand Avenue (estimated cost \$218,000)

- New pavement and curb & gutter.
- New sidewalk on one side of street.
- Water main and service replacement.
- Minor storm water repairs.
- Minor sanitary sewer repairs

7th Street Reconstruction – Ray Street to Grand Avenue (estimated cost \$204,000)

- Storm water work.
- Minor sanitary sewer repairs

7th Street Reconstruction – Oak Street to Lincoln Avenue (estimated cost \$375,000)

- New pavement and curb & gutter.
- New sidewalk on one side of street.
- Water main and service replacement.
- Storm water work.
- Minor sanitary sewer repairs

8th Street Reconstruction – Oak Street to Lincoln Avenue (estimated cost \$375,000)

- New pavement and curb & gutter.
- New sidewalk on one side of street.
- Water main and service replacement.
- Storm water work.
- Minor sanitary sewer repairs

The Forest Subdivision Reconstruction – Woodland Trail, E Woodland Trail, Forest Glenn Circle, W Woodland Trail, Highland Trail, Highland Ct., White Pine Ct., and Red Pine Ct. (estimated cost \$753,000)

- Full replacement of asphalt.
 - Base course replacement as necessary.
 - Sidewalk ramp replacement.
 - Sidewalk spot replacement.
 - Curb and gutter spot replacement.
- Minor storm water repairs.

Avoid a Snow Emergency Parking Ticket

The Village of Prairie du Sac requires that all vehicles be off the streets once there is a snow accumulation of 2 inches of snow to allow for snow plowing. This parking restriction remains in effect for 48 hours after the snow has stopped or until the streets are cleared. During this restriction, parking is available in the following municipal lots: Water Street, Third Street, Fourth Street, Washington Street and Galeana Street Public Lots. Minimum penalty is \$20.

Attention Dog & Cat Owners

Dog and cat licenses expire on December 31st of each year. The owner of any dog or cat more than five (5) months of age on January 1 of any year, or five (5) months of age within the license year, shall annually, or on or before the date the animal becomes five (5) months of age, pay a license tax and obtain a license from the Village. Licenses are a good tool in reuniting pet owners with lost pets. Neutered/Spayed is \$10.00 annually prior to April 1. Unneutered/Unspayed is \$30.00 annually prior to April 1. Late Fee of \$5.00 additional after April 1. The owner of a dog or cat shall have the animal vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian within thirty (30) days after the animal reaches four (4) months of age, proof of vaccination must be provided at licensing.

It shall be unlawful for any person within the Village of Prairie du Sac to own, harbor or keep any dog or cat which:

- (1) Habitually pursues any vehicle upon any public street, alley or highway in the Village.
- (2) Assaults or attacks any person or destroys property.
- (3) Is at large within the limits of the Village.
- (4) Habitually barks or howls to the annoyance of any person or persons.
- (5) Kills, wounds or worries any domestic animal.
- (6) Is known by such person to be infected with rabies or to have been bitten by an animal known to have been infected with rabies.
- (7) Is unlicensed.

Dogs are not allowed within Village Parks.

The owner or person in charge of any dog or other animal shall not permit solid



fecal matter of such animal to deposit on any street, alley or other public or private property, unless such matter is immediately removed by said owner or person in charge. Anyone walking a dog without proper cleanup materials may be deemed in violation of Village Code. All pens, yards, structures or areas where animals are kept shall be maintained in a nuisance-free manner. Droppings and manure shall be removed regularly and disposed of properly so not to attract insects or rodents, becoming unsightly or cause objectionable odors.
