FALL CLEAN UP

Loose leaves and grass clippings will be picked up using the Leaf Vacuum in the Fall from approximately October 1 thru November 15 (dependent upon the weather). Loose leaves and grass clippings should be placed in the tree bank, not in the gutter or street. Please **no sticks** or the Leaf Vacuum will not be able to pick up. There are no set days of when they will be in your neighborhood.

FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING

The Village of Prairie du Sac Water Utility tentatively plans to flush fire hydrants October 7 to October 23, 2020, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday—Friday. It may be necessary to adjust these dates due to weather conditions. Schedule updates will be provided via the Nixle notification system. The process of periodically “flushing” fire hydrants is an important preventative maintenance activity to insure the integrity of the water system and deliver the highest quality water to our customers. The Village flushes hydrants twice a year, usually in the spring and fall. Hydrant flushing serves the following purposes:

- Flushes sediments from mainline pipes, which enhances water quality.
- Verifies the proper operation of fire hydrants and valves.
- Aids in determining weaknesses in the water system.
- Helps to identify closed valves and weak flows in the water main.
- Verifies ample water flow for firefighting.



As a result of hydrant flushing, residents in the immediate vicinity may experience temporary discoloration of their water. This discoloration is harmless, and generally consists of precipitates which do not affect the safety of water consumption. If you notice that your water is discolored, you can clear this issue by running all water faucets inside your home for approximately 15 minutes, or until the water clears. If water does not clear, please contact the Village at 643-4769. It is important you **do not wash laundry during flushing in your neighborhood** or while water is cloudy or discolored. Please wait until water is clear before laundering. The Village does not accept responsibility for clothing reported as soiled or damaged when washed in cloudy or discolored water.



The CDC has stated traditional trick-or-treating where treats are handed to children who go door to door and other traditional Halloween activities can be high-risk for spreading viruses, such as COVID-19. If you choose to go trick-or-treating, the village recommends limiting the activity to Oct. 31 from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Homes participating in trick-or-treating should turn their porch lights on. If you do not wish to participate, please leave your porch light off. The village encourages everyone to follow CDC guidelines related to Halloween activities, such as participating in one-way trick-or-treating where individually wrapped goodie bags are lined up for families to grab and go while continuing to social distance (such as at the end of a driveway or at the edge of a yard). **Important Dates to Remember for the
 November Election**

October 14, 2020: Final day to register by mail or online. Visit <https://myvote.wi.gov> to complete the registration process in minutes or visit the municipal clerk's office at 335 Galena Street.

October 15 to October 30, 2020: During this closed registration period, you must register to vote at the municipal clerk's office.

October 20, 2020 to October 30, 2020: In-person absentee voting at the Village Hall will be available. Our hours for voting will be Monday through Friday from 9am to 5pm. You will need to present your photo id.

October 30, 2020: Final day to register to vote at your municipal clerk's office.

November 3, 2020: Election Day. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. at the Village Hall, 335 Galena Street.
