



RESOLUTION No. 03-10-2020(b)

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING STREET AND UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS AND
LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS AGAINST BENEFITTED PROPERTIES INTENT
RE: 6TH STREET, 7TH STREET, 8TH STREET, WOODLAND TRAIL, E.
WOODLAND TRAIL, FOREST GLEN CIRCLE, HIGHLAND TRAIL, HIGHLAND
COURT, WHITE PINE COURT, W. WOODLAND TRAIL, AND RED PINE COURT**

WHEREAS, the Prairie du Sac Village Board on March 10, 2020, held a public hearing on the levying of special assessments through a preliminary resolution, and received the report of the Village Engineer on the proposed street and utility improvements, including the replacement of driveways, carriage walks, and private walks on the following street:

1. All properties having frontage on 6th Street from Ray Street to Grand Avenue; and
2. All properties having frontage on 7th Street from Oak Street to Lincoln Avenue and from Ray Street to Grand Avenue; and
3. All properties having frontage on 8th Street from Oak Street to Lincoln Avenue; and
4. All properties having frontage on Woodland Trail, E. Woodland Trail, Forest Glen Circle, Highland Trail, Highland Court, White Pine Court, W. Woodland Trail, and Red Pine Court


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of Prairie du Sac as follows:

1. That the report of the Village Engineer pertaining to the construction of the above-described public improvements, including plans and specifications therefore is adopted and approved.
2. That the Public Works/Utilities Committee of the Village Board has authorized the advertisement for bids and conducting the improvements stated in accordance with the report of the Village Engineer.
3. That payment for the driveway, carriage walk, and private walk be made by assessing the cost to the property benefited as indicated in the report pursuant to the Resolution #01-28-2020(h).
4. Those assessments shown on the report, representing an exercise of the police power, have been determined on a reasonable basis and are hereby confirmed.
5. That the assessments for improvements included in the report are hereby combined as a single assessment but any interested property owner may object to each assessment separately or all assessments jointly for any purpose.


6. That the assessments may be paid to the Village Treasurer, either in cash or in installments. Installment payments shall bear interest on the amount due at the rate of five point twenty-five percent (5.25%) per annum for a maximum of five (5) years. Said annual installment payments of principal and interest shall not be less than \$100.00. Installments or assessments not paid when due shall bear additional interest on the amount due at the rate of two percent (2%) per annum.
7. That the Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this resolution and a statement of the final assessment against the benefited property to every property owner within the assessment district.
